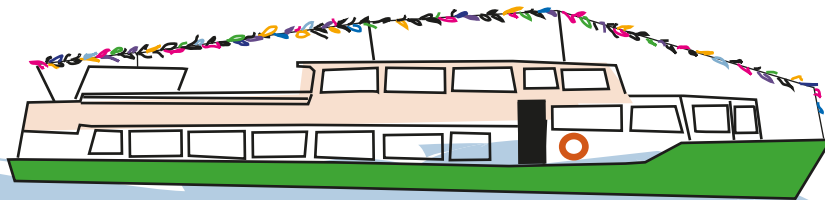


2-hour Lake Cruise on Lake Baldeney + Coffee & Cake

Cologne: Cathedral & Chocolate Museum

07:50 a.m.: Meeting Point: In front of „DM“, Essen main station.

08:09 a.m.: Train journey from Essen to Cologne. Travel by regional train is included in your Deutschlandsemesterticket.

09:12 a.m.: Arrival at Cologne Central Station. If(!) the train arrives on time, there will be enough time to get coffee and/or a small breakfast from the bakeries at the station.

10:35 a.m.: Start of the cathedral tour at DOMFORUM, Domkloster 3, 50667 Cologne. Cologne Cathedral is one of the largest Gothic cathedrals and was built from 1248 to 1880. It is a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of the most popular sights in Germany. The guided tour is held in English and, if you prefer, in German for part of the group.

11:45 a.m. – 12:15 p.m.: Walk from Cologne Cathedral to the chocolate museum

12:30 p.m.: Visit to the Chocolate Museum. The Cologne Chocolate Museum shows the history of chocolate from its beginnings to the present day. A small production facility demonstrates the industrial production of chocolate. Living cocoa trees can be seen in the tropical house. The highlight of the exhibition is the chocolate fountain, where visitors can taste chocolate.

Ca. 02:00 p.m.: Official end of the trip and free time in Cologne. From the Chocolate Museum, you can easily walk to many other sights, shops and cafés in the center of Cologne. The return journey to Essen can be made individually – preferably by regional train (RE, RB or S), which can be used with the Deutschlandsemesterticket.

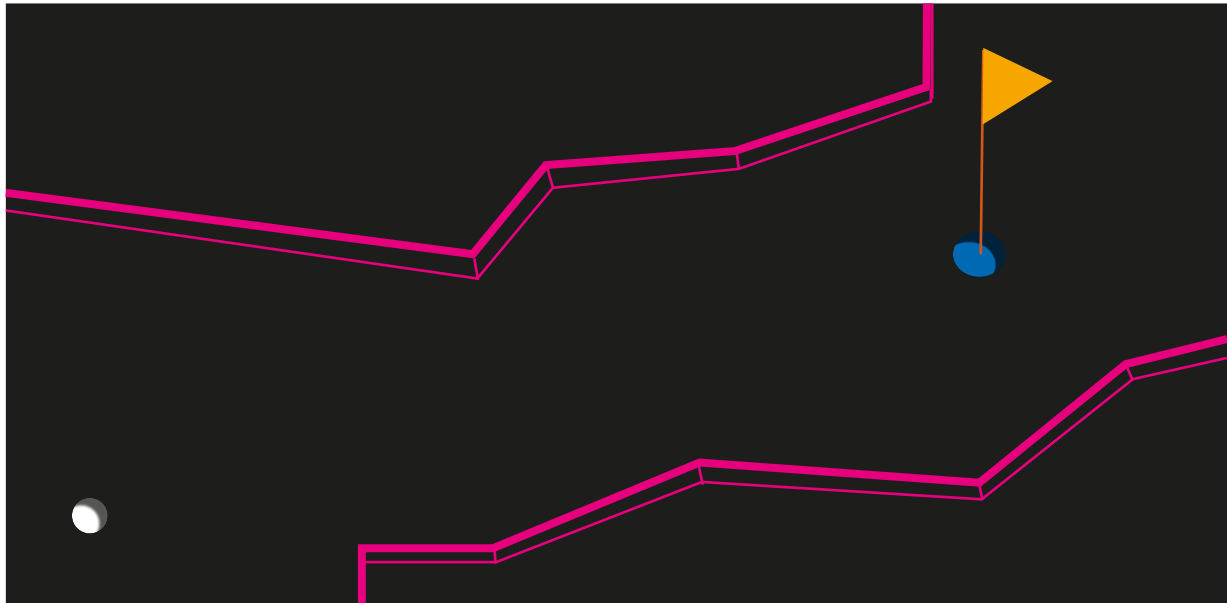
